| <p>Children's Centre Update: Debbie updated the group (see Children's Centre update BVCC/NN and Wellies CC) Becki updated the group (see Children's Centre update Lighthorne Heath CC and NN) Ellen Stone- gave a NHS update: School Nursing service has gone out to tender so is not run by Health Visiting WCC will go out to tender in the next two years, and due to this the plan for Janice Cook and Paddi Nowlan are not able to move into LHCC. Health visiting teams are fully staffed with a new Health Visitor starting in Shipston due to a large case load.</p> | |
| <p>Performance Management: Debbie was able to share the South Warwickshire Profile Data with the meeting. We looked at the data which was updated by WCC recently. We had a discussion around %'s of registrations, engagement and sustained engaged. Mary highlighted the consultation regarding the Ofsted, who are now not inspecting for the rest of the academic year. Barbara has been trying to find if there are any exceptions to this but is still awaiting to hear form the Ofsted local lead. Becki and Debbie are due to meet to look at this new data and identify targets/areas of work.</p> | |

| <p>Children's Centre Sessions/Services: Physio therapy drop in is still in wellies – Debbie to send details out Speech and language drop in at Wellies Counselling is being delivered out of Badger Valley and Lighthorne Heath and is becoming a valuable service, as well as protecting children from significant harm. Elaine Johnson explained how important and useful this service is and how important it is to gain funding to help it continue.</p> | |
