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| <p>Welcome & apologies</p> <p>CJ as chair as no chair or vice chair were present, she welcomed all those attending this Advisory Board meeting.</p> | |
| <p>Centre Updates</p> <p>ACFC Staff are now in place following restructure. We have 5 EYFW and one of those is in place until Oct 18. All are part time. We have two admins both part time.</p> <p>All EYFW are up to capacity family support wise.</p> <p>Alcester had its open day 8th June. It was hugely successful and Pip the penguin was introduced. Lots of new families came that we had not had contact with before.</p> <p>SCFC</p> <p>Again staff are in place and there are 5 EYFW in place all part time. Also two admins. All EYFW are up to capacity with family support and there is a waiting list.</p> <p>Stratford had their open day yesterday and have one for Badger Valley next week on Tuesday. The Stratford open day went very well and there were lots of professionals there that made good links.</p> <p>Perinatal mental health team will be moving into SCFC on a Wednesday</p> | |
| <p>Outreach Update</p> <p>In the Alcester reach we have baby massage and Chatter Matters taking place at Studley Methodist church, Chatter matters at Henley Hub and baby massage at Bidford. We have postnatal welcome sessions in Salford Priors, Henley, Studley and Bidford at the Barn.</p> | |

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| <p>In Stratford currently outreach is taking place mostly at Badger Valley (two days a week), Clopton and at Tyler House. In July Ken Kennett is opening again. Orbit are running a community partnership program in Clopton which SCFC may be a part of.</p> | |
| <p>Partner Service Update</p> <p>FIS have a brokerage service</p> <p>P3 are at Tesco by the foodbank on Fri 12 -2 and at the Lomas suite Wed 1-4. They work with anyone who has housing issues.</p> <p>Marilyn Price - Citizens Advice</p> <p>Now known as Citizens Advice Nationally not CAB. Stratford branch has now amalgamated with Warwick/ Leamington. Stratford area is very rural covering 377 square miles. The Reach out and Help program is operational throughout all of our CC reach including villages.</p> <p>A new Chief Executive has been appointed - Jeremy Vaine and will start in August.</p> <p>Electronic referrals are welcome.</p> <p>Sam Game - SWFT</p> <p>SWFT won the contract for Solihull 0-19 and the Coventry. HV's are now set up with a new pathway. Working on a family plan for everyone which will work at different levels. This will probably be linked to the red book. Everyone will be on electronic records by next year.</p> <p>Operationally the HV's are very busy. Wellesbourne HV's have moved into the GP's and clinic has moved to St Peter's. The new GP surgery in Wellesbourne will open in Jan.</p> | |
| <p>Safeguarding</p> <p>Alcester are working with 2 CP, 2 CIN and no Early help. One case has a serious safeguarding issue for Mum and a picture of her perpetrator is on the Alcester Wall. Staff to dial 999 if seen.</p> <p>Stratford have put in two recent referrals to MASH however they have been refused and referred to Early Help. Nicky may escalate if necessary (discussion with Sam Game took place around escalation).</p> | |
